The Commemoration provides a Vietnam Veteran Lapel Pin for dignified public presentations to living U.S. military veterans who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces at any time during the period from November 1, 1955, to May 15, 1975, regardless of location.



The Commemoration also established a series of Certificate of Honor lapel pins to recognize the unique service and sacrifice of certain veterans and family members. This is a special lapel pin presented to a surviving spouse, at the time of death, of a Vietnam veteran who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces at any time during the period 1 November 1955 to 15 May 1975, regardless of the location of service.
